Thank you to all the exhibitors for braving the very strong winds and squally showers and managing to present their exhibits beautifully throughout it all. Dentition was very good throughout my entry and I found good bone and tighter feet since I last judged. Movement was hard to assess at times due to the gusts of high wind and some exhibitors should remember the breed standard calls for a 'suggestion of speed' and would have benefitted from moving slower to allow straight movement and powerful drive from the hindquarters to be shown.

Special Beginners Dog (1.0)

1st – Wilkinson's Phenset Firestorm. Mature 3 year old o/b dog with a masculine head and pleasing expression. Good reach of neck into clean shoulders. A little upright in upper arm. Deep firm body with good spring of rib. Would like more rear angulation. In lovely coat and condition and well presented. Movement ok but with rather high tail carriage.

Minor Puppy Dog (3.1)

1st & BP – Stewart & Quenby's Tattersett Stolen Silver. A well put together b/b puppy. Balanced head, well defined stop and dark eyes. Low set ears. Clean neck into well placed shoulders flowing to a level top line and tail set. Deep compact body with good spring of ribs. Nicely angulated front and rear. In good coat and condition. Moved steadily using his tail.

2nd – Carlin's Ennydloc Yorkshire Image. Another nice puppy but in the 'gangly' stage. Stronger head than 1st with deeper flews. Good stop and low set ears. Good reach of neck. Not so clean in shoulder placement. Good spring of ribs. Low tailset. Moved ok. Needs to grow into himself.

1st – Murray's Callaset Moonlight. Mature tri dog. Rather heavy in head. Ear set could be lower. Good reach of neck and clean shoulders. Upright in upper arm. Needs to tighten up in front. Lacking in spring of rib and rear angulation. Difficult to assess movement as he was very erratic and rather too strong for his handler.

Post Graduate Dog (3.0)

1st - Stewart & Quenby's Tattersett Golden Sunrise. O/b dog. Masculine head with soft expression and dark eye. Good reach of neck with clean shoulders. Deep chest, firm body and level top line. Very well muscled. Would have liked better rear angulation. In very good coat and condition. Moved well using his tail. Well presented.

2nd – Wilkinson's Phenset Firestorm.

3rd – Whittington's Juldeane Line of Duty

1st & RCC – Sykes' Bumble Corn Robin at Daraquist. Lovely b/b dog. Compact and well put together. Nicely worked head with super expression. Good reach of neck into clean shoulders. Firm level top line and tail set. Deep body with well sprung ribs. Well off for bone. Good angulation. Moved well. In good coat and well presented.

2nd – Taylor's Bumblecorn Ash of Tattay. Litter brother to 1st. Larger framed tri dog. Balanced head with good expression. Good reach of neck and clean shoulders. Deep body with good spring of rib. Nice bend of stifle. Well muscled. In good coat and condition. Moved well. Well presented.

3rd – Whiting & Grant's Tattersett Many Clouds at Ormstiga CJW22 Ir J Ch

Open Dog (4.0)

1st CC & BOB – Watts' Walshaw Brushstrokes. A well balanced tri dog with such clean lines; looked a picture standing. Balanced masculine head but not overdone, with dark eyes and low ear set. Good reach of neck into flowing shoulders with level top line and tail set. Deep chest and good spring of ribs. Firm body with excellent rear angulation. Well muscled second thigh. Moved with drive using his tail. Excellent presentation, in full coat. I understand this CC made him a very worthy Show Champion – well done.

2nd – Danks-Kemish's Sh Ch Ravensett Work of Art at Alolfrana JW. Well constructed quality o/b dog. Pleasing overall picture. Super head with melting expression. Clean neck and shoulders. Short coupled with firm quarters. In good condition, just lacking in coat to complete the picture. Well presented. Moved well.

3rd - Whiting & Grant's Tattersett Many Clouds at Ormstiga CJW22 Ir J Ch

2nd – Beasley's Wansleydale Amaretto. Tri bitch. Larger framed than 1st. Pleasing head. Good reach of neck. Little straight in upper arm. Level top line. Good angulation. In good condition. Moved ok.

2nd – Beasley's Wansleydale Mayflower. Compact dark tri bitch making a lovely overall picture when stood. Lovely head and expression. Good reach of neck. Level top line and tailset. In good coat and condition. Moved ok. Well presented.

3rd – Dykes' Caleydene Connextion

Limit Bitch (7.1)

1st & RCC – Montell's Culverwell Sign of the Angel. Dark b/b bitch full of ring presence. Sweet head and expression. Good reach of neck, short coupled with a deep compact body. Good angulation front and rear. In good coat and condition. Scored on straight, true movement using her tail.

2nd – Dykes' Wansleydale Bedazzled at Caleydene. A well presented tri bitch with pleasing head and expression. Good reach of neck. Short coupled and deep body. Top line ok but tail set could be better. Rear angulation ok - would like more bend of stifle. Moved well.

3rd – Tucker's Walshaw Save the Last Dance

Open Bitch (5.0)

1st CC & BOS - Grimsdell's Tattersett Dark Honey JW. A beautifully constructed o/b bitch with a very pleasing overall outline. Balanced head with dark eye and beautiful expression. Low set ears and good reach of neck. Well laid shoulders into level top line and tailset. Deep chest and well sprung ribs. Firm body. Good rear angulation. Moved steadily using her tail. Presented in excellent coat and condition.

2nd – Mugford's Sh Ch Alolfrana Sugar N'Spice at Lynwood JW. Well constructed tri bitch. Nice head. Super reach of neck. Lovely to go over, such clean lines. Not the rear angulation of 1st. In good coat and condition with excellent presentation. Moved well.

3rd – Culverwell's Cast a Spell

Veteran Bitch (1.0)

1st & BV. Tucker's Niddbeck Smokey Opal at Walshaw JW. Lovely headed tri bitch. Lovely shaped dark eye and sweet expression. Good reach of neck. Level top line and tailset. Firm body with well sprung ribs. Well angulated front and rear. In good coat and well presented. Lovely movement using her tail. Delighted to see her shortlisted in the Veteran Group.
